

## 1 CHRONICLES CHAPTER 2

<sup>1</sup> These *are* the names of the sons of Israel: <sup>2</sup> Reuben, Simeon, Levi, Judah, Issachar, Zebulun, Dan, Joseph, Benjamin, Naphtali, Gad, and Asher.

<sup>3</sup> The sons of Judah *were* Er, Onan, and Shelah. *These* three were born to him of the daughter of Shua the Canaanite woman. And Er, the firstborn of Judah, *was* wicked before the Lord, and He killed him. <sup>4</sup> And Tamar his daughter-in-law bore to him Perez and Zerah. All the sons of Judah *were* five. <sup>5</sup> The sons of Perez *were* Hezron and Hamul. <sup>6</sup> And the sons of Zerah *were* Zimri, Ethan, Heman, Calcol, and Dara—five *in* all. <sup>7</sup> And the son of Carmi *was* Achar the troubler of Israel, who was disobedient in the accursed thing. <sup>8</sup> And the son of Ethan *was* Azariah.

<sup>9</sup> Also the sons of Hezron who were born to him *were* Jerahmeel, Ram, and Chelubai. <sup>10</sup> And Ram fathered Amminadab, and Amminadab fathered Nahshon, chief of the house of Judah. <sup>11</sup> And Nahshon fathered Salma, and Salmon fathered Boaz, <sup>12</sup> and Boaz fathered Obed, and Obed fathered Jesse. <sup>13</sup> And Jesse fathered his firstborn Eliab, Abinadab *was* his second, Shimea the third, <sup>14</sup> Nethanel the fourth, Raddai the fifth, <sup>15</sup> Ozem the sixth, *and* David the seventh. <sup>16</sup> And their sisters *were* Zeruiah and Abigail. And the sons of Zeruiah *were* Abishai, Joab, and Asahel, three. <sup>17</sup> And Abigail bore Amasa; and the father of Amasa *was* Jether the Ishmaelite.

<sup>18</sup> And Caleb the son of Hezron took Azubah to wife, by Jerioth. Now these *were* her sons: Jeshur, Shobab, and Ardon. <sup>19</sup> And Azubah died; and Caleb took to himself Ephrath *as a wife*, and she bore to him Hur. <sup>20</sup> And Hur fathered Uri, and Uri fathered Bezalel.

<sup>21</sup> And after this Hezron went in to the daughter of Machir the father of Gilead, and he took her when he was sixty-five years old; and she bore him Segub. <sup>22</sup> And Segub fathered Jair, and he had twenty-three cities in Gilead. <sup>23</sup> And he took Geshur and Aram, the towns of Jair from them; *with* Kenath and its towns, sixty cities. All these *belonged to* the sons of Machir the father of Gilead. <sup>24</sup> And after the death of Hezron, Caleb came to Ephrathah; and the wife of Hezron *was* Abijah; and she bore him Ashur the father of Tekoa.

<sup>25</sup> And the sons of Jerahmeel the firstborn of Hezron *were* Ram, the firstborn, and Bunah, Oren, and Ozem his brother. <sup>26</sup> And Jerahmeel had another wife, and her name *was* Atarah. She is the mother of Onam. <sup>27</sup> And the sons of Ram the firstborn of Jerahmeel *were* Maaz, Jamin, and Eker. <sup>28</sup> And the sons of Onam *were* Shammai, and Jada. And the sons of Shammai *were* Nadab and Abishur. <sup>29</sup> And the name of the wife of Abishur *was* Abihail, and she bore him Ahban and Molid. <sup>30</sup> And the sons of Nadab *were* Seled and Appaim. And Seled died without children. <sup>31</sup> And the son of Appaim *was* Ishi; and the son of Ishi *was* Sheshan; and the son of Sheshan *was* Ahlai. <sup>32</sup> And the sons of Jada *were* Jether and Jonathan. And Jether died childless. <sup>33</sup> And the sons of Jonathan *were* Peleth and Zaza. These were the sons of Jerahmeel.

<sup>34</sup> Now Sheshan had no sons, but daughters. And Sheshan had an Egyptian servant, and his name *was* Jarha. <sup>35</sup> And Sheshan gave his daughter to Jarha his servant as wife, and she bore him Attai. <sup>36</sup> And Attai fathered Nathan, and Nathan fathered Zabad, <sup>37</sup> and Zabad fathered Ephlal, and Ephlal fathered

Obed; <sup>38</sup> and Obed fathered Jehu, and Jehu fathered Azariah; <sup>39</sup> and Azariah fathered Helez, and Helez fathered Eleasah, <sup>40</sup> and Eleasah fathered Sismai, and Sismai fathered Shallum, <sup>41</sup> and Shallum fathered Jekamiah, and Jekamiah fathered Elishama, and Elishama fathered Ishmael.

<sup>42</sup> And the sons of Caleb the brother of Jerahmeel *were* Mesha his firstborn, he *is* the father of Ziph; and the sons of Mareshah the father of Hebron. <sup>43</sup> And the sons of Hebron *were* Korah, Tappuah, Rekem, and Shema. <sup>44</sup> And Shema fathered Raham the father of Jorkoam: and Jorkoam fathered Shammai. <sup>45</sup> And his son *was* Maon; and Maon *is* the father of Beth Zur. <sup>46</sup> And Ephah the concubine of Caleb bore Haran, Moza, and Gazez. <sup>47</sup> And the sons of Jahdai *were* Regem, Jotham, Geshan, Pelet, Ephah, and Shaaph. <sup>48</sup> And Caleb's concubine Maachah bore Sheber and Tirhanah. <sup>49</sup> She also bore Shaaph the father of Madmannah, and Sheva the father of Machbenah, and the father of Gibeon. And the daughter of Caleb *was* Achsah.

<sup>50</sup> These were the sons of Caleb: the sons of Hur the firstborn of Ephrathah *were* Shobal the father of Kirjath Jearim, <sup>51</sup> Salma the father of Bethlehem, and Hareph the father of Beth Gader. <sup>52</sup> And the descendants of Shobal the father of Kirjath Jearim *were* *the* Haroeh, and the Manuhoth, <sup>53</sup> and the Shumathites, the Aethalim, the Miphithim, the Hesamathim, and the Hemasaraim; from these went forth the Zorathites and the Eshtaolites. <sup>54</sup> The sons of Salma *were* Bethlehem, the Netophathites, Atroth Beth Joab, and half of the family of Malathi, Esari. <sup>55</sup> The families of the scribes dwelling in Jabez *were* the Tirathites, the Shimeathites, and the Suchathites, these *were* the Kenites that came from Hammath, the father of the house of Rechab.
