

## 1 CHRONICLES CHAPTER 9

<sup>1</sup> And *this is* all Israel, *even* their enrollment; and these *are* written down in the book of the kings of Israel and Judah, with the *names of them* that were carried away to Babylon for their transgressions. <sup>2</sup> And those that dwelt before in their possessions in the cities of Israel, the priests, the Levites, and the appointed ones.

<sup>3</sup> And there dwelt in Jerusalem some of the children of Judah, and of the children of Benjamin, and of the children of Ephraim, and Manasseh. <sup>4</sup> And Uthai the son of Ammihud, the son of Omri, the son of Imri, the son of Bani, son of the sons of Perez, the son of Judah. <sup>5</sup> And of the Shilonites: Asaiah the firstborn, and his sons. <sup>6</sup> Of the sons of Zerah: Jeuel, and their brothers, six hundred and ninety. <sup>7</sup> And of the sons of Benjamin: Sallu, son of Meshullam, son of Hodaviah, son of Hassenuah; <sup>8</sup> and Ibneiah son of Jeroham, and Elah: these *are* the sons of Uzzi, the son of Michri; Meshullam, son of Shephatiah, son of Reuel, son of Ibnijah; <sup>9</sup> and their brothers according to their generations, nine hundred and fifty-six; all the men *were* heads of families according to the houses of their fathers.

<sup>10</sup> And of the priests: Jedaiah, Jehoiarib, and Jachin; <sup>11</sup> Azaria the son of Hilkiyah, the son of Meshullam, the son of Zadok, the son of Meraioth, the son of Ahitub, the officer over the house of God; <sup>12</sup> and Adaiah son of Jeroham, son of Pashur, son of Malchijah, Maasai son of Adiel, son of Jahzerah, son of Meshullam, son of Meshillemith, son of Immer; <sup>13</sup> and their brothers, chiefs of their families, a thousand seven hundred and sixty, mighty *men* for the work of the ministration of the house of God.

<sup>14</sup> And of the Levites: Shemaiah son of Hasshub, son of Azrikam, son of Hashabiah, of the sons of Merari; <sup>15</sup> Bakbakkar, Heresh, Galal, and Mattaniah son of Micah, son of Zichri, son of Asaph; <sup>16</sup> Obadiah, son of Shemaiah, son of Galal, son of Jeduthun, and Berechiah son of Asa, son of Elkanah, who dwelt in the villages of the Netophathites.

<sup>17</sup> The gatekeepers *were* Shallum, Akkub, Talmon, Ahiman, and their brothers; Shallum *was* the chief. <sup>18</sup> And *he was stationed* there in the king's gate eastward; these *are* the gates of the companies of the sons of Levi. <sup>19</sup> And Shallum the son of Kore, the son of Ebiasaph, the son of Korah, and his brothers belonging to the house of his father, the Korahites *were* over the works of the service, keeping the watches of the tabernacle, and their fathers over the camp of the Lord, keeping the entrance. <sup>20</sup> And Phinehas son of Eleazar was head over them before the Lord, and these *were* with him. <sup>21</sup> Zechariah the son of Meshelemiah *was* keeper of the door of the tabernacle of witness. <sup>22</sup> All the chosen porters in the gates *were* two hundred and twelve, these *were* in their courts, *this was* their distribution: these David and Samuel the seer established in their charge. <sup>23</sup> And these and their sons *were* over the gates in the house of the Lord, and in the house of the tabernacle, to keep watch. <sup>24</sup> The gates were toward the four winds, east, west, north, and south. <sup>25</sup> And their brothers *were* in their courts, to enter in weekly from time to time with these. <sup>26</sup> For four strong *men* have the charge of the gates; and the Levites were over the chambers, and they keep watch over the treasures of the house of God. <sup>27</sup> For the charge *was* upon them, and these *were* charged with the keys to open the doors of the temple every morning.

<sup>28</sup> And *some* of them *were appointed* over the vessels of service, that they should carry them in by number, and carry them out by number. <sup>29</sup> And *some* of them *were* appointed over the furniture, and over all the holy vessels, and over the fine flour, the wine, the oil, the frankincense, and the spices. <sup>30</sup> And some of the priests were makers of the ointment, and *appointed to prepare* the spices. <sup>31</sup> And Mattithiah of the Levites, (he *was* the firstborn of Shallum the Korahite) *was set* in charge over the sacrifices of meat offerings of the pan belonging to the high priest. <sup>32</sup> And Banaiah the Kohathite *was set* over the showbread, from among his brothers, to prepare it every Sabbath.

<sup>33</sup> And these *were* the singers, heads of families of the Levites, *to whom were* established daily courses, for they were employed in the services day and night. <sup>34</sup> These *were* the heads of the families of the Levites according to their generations; these chiefs dwelt in Jerusalem. <sup>35</sup> And Jeiel the father of Gibeon dwelt in Gibeon; and his wife's name *was* Maacah. <sup>36</sup> And his firstborn son *was* Abdon, then Zur, Kish, Baal, Ner, Nadab, <sup>37</sup> Gedor and *his* brother, Zecher, and Mikloth. <sup>38</sup> And Mikloth fathered Shimeam. And these dwelt in the midst of their brothers in Jerusalem, *even* in the midst of their brothers. <sup>39</sup> And Ner fathered Kish, and Kish fathered Saul, and Saul fathered Jonathan, Malchishua, Abinadab, and Esh-Baal. <sup>40</sup> And the son of Jonathan *was* Merib-Baal, and Merib-Baal fathered Micah. <sup>41</sup> And the sons of Micah *were* Pithon, Melech, Tarea, and Ahaz <sup>42</sup> And Ahaz fathered Jarah; Jarah fathered Alemeth, Azmaveth, and Zimri; and Zimri fathered Moza. <sup>43</sup> Moza fathered Binea, Rephaiah *was* his son, Eleasah his son, and Azel his son. <sup>44</sup> And Azel had six sons, and these *were* their names: Azrikam his firstborn, then Ishmael, Sheariah, Obadiah, Hanan, and Asa: these *were* the sons of Azel.
