

PSALM 29

- ¹ A Psalm of David, *on the occasion* of the solemn assembly of the Tabernacle. Bring to the Lord, you sons of God, bring to the Lord young rams; bring to the Lord glory and honor.
- ² Bring to the Lord the glory *due* to His name; worship the Lord in His holy court.
- ³ The voice of the Lord is upon the waters; the God of glory has thundered; the Lord is upon many waters.
- ⁴ The voice of the Lord is mighty; the voice of the Lord is full of majesty.
- ⁵ The voice of the Lord breaks the cedars; the Lord will break the cedars of Lebanon.
- ⁶ And He will beat them small, *even* Lebanon itself, like a calf; and the beloved one is as a young unicorn.
- ⁷ The voice of the Lord divides the flames of fire.
- ⁸ The voice of the Lord shakes the wilderness; the Lord will shake the wilderness of Kadesh.
- ⁹ The voice of the Lord strengthens the deer, and will uncover the thickets; and in His temple everyone speaks *of His* glory.
- ¹⁰ The Lord will dwell on the waterflood; and the Lord will sit as King forever.
- ¹¹ The Lord will give strength to His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace.
